

# BOAT PARKING PROCEDURES

## DOCKING YOUR BOAT

### APPROACHING SLOWLY

APPROACH THE DOCK AT IDLE SPEED, ALLOWING YOUR BOAT'S MOMENTUM TO GENTLY BEGIN THE DRIVE-IN PROCESS



### "SAFETY PAUSE"

GENTLY APPLY THROTTLE TO HOLD YOUR BOAT IN A "SAFETY PAUSE" POSITION ABOUT 1/3 OF THE WAY ONTO THE DOCK



### COMPLETE DRIVE-ON

WHEN READY, FIRMLY THROTTLE THE REST OF THE WAY TO GET FULLY ON THE DOCK



Caution: Colliding into the dock can cause damage or injuries

## UNDOCKING YOUR BOAT

### LOWER OUTDRIVE & REVERSE

LOWER YOUR OUTDRIVE MOTOR INTO THE WATER. IDLE MOTOR FOR A MINUTE OR TWO THEN REVERSE AT A LOW SPEED: SHIFT INTO REVERSE AT A LOW SPEED FOR A FEW SECONDS



### GENTLY SLIDE OFF THE DOCK

INCREASE THE THROTTLE SPEED IN REVERSE, AND THE BOAT WILL GENTLY SLIDE OFF THE DOCK
